

London Youth Choirs exists to enrich the lives of young Londoners through singing, by providing children and young people living or educated in London with top quality choral singing tuition and unique performance opportunities.

The LYC family currently consists of ten choirs with a membership of nearly 500 young people aged 7-23. We also run a wider schools engagement programme

which sees a further 1,000 children take part in our singing activities each year.

All LYC sessions are designed to educate and inspire, build confidence, and develop skills in teamwork and leadership - all whilst championing inclusivity and understanding.

London Youth Choirs aims to be truly representative of the population of London and currently works with young people from 31 of the 32 London boroughs.

LYC aims to be a warm, welcoming, professional and ambitious organisation.


You will thrive with us if you:

LYC runs ten choirs - six in central London, and one each in Streatham, Ealing, Bermondsey and Tottenham. You can see more information about the choirs in the diagram below:



#### The LYC Freelance Team

Each choir is a led by a Conductor and supported by a Pianist and up to three Assistant Leaders. We have vacancies for Assistant Leaders in seven of our choirs - please see the following page for details.

In addition to our regular freelance team, we also maintain a deputy list for all our choirs. During the application process, you will have the opportunity to indicate your availability to deputise at rehearsals for other choirs in the LYC family.

# ASSISTANT LEADER PERSON SPECIFICATION

LYC is looking for proactive and committed Assistant Leaders to bolster our 35-strong freelance team for the 24-25 academic year. With the continued growth of our Junior and Cambiata choirs - particularly in the boys' choirs - we are aiming to recruit extra Assistant Leaders to support our Conductors and other staff at regular weekly rehearsals, as well as at concerts and events across London.

The specific Assistant Leader roles we are recruiting for are as follows:

- LYC Junior Boys 4.00-6.00pm on Mondays at City of London School, EC4V 3AL
- LYC Junior Girls 4.00-6.00pm on Mondays at City of London School, EC4V 3AL
- LYC Cambiata Girls 5.45-7.45pm on Mondays at City of London School, EC4V 3AL
- LYC South West 3.45-5.45pm on Wednesdays at Streatham & Clapham High School, SW16 1AW
- LYC West 3.45-5.45pm on Thursdays at St Barnabas Church, W5 1QG
- LYC North East 3.45-5.45pm on Thursdays at the Bernie Grant Arts Centre, N15 4RX
- LYC South East 3.45-5.45pm on Thursdays at City Hope Church, SE16 2JY

### **Knowledge, Skills and Experience**

### **Essential**

- A passion for working with young people
- · An interest in singing, especially in a group setting
- Confident, independent, and self-motivated
- An excellent team player who is helpful and collaborative
- Sensitive, aware, and compassionate towards any challenges our young people might be facing
- An excellent role model who is willing to be a positive advocate for the work of London Youth Choirs

### **Desirable**

- A music education background and the ability to read music
- Experience supporting young people with additional needs
- First aid trained

## **ASSISTANT LEADER**

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Being a positive role model
- Supporting members at rehearsals and performances (e.g. helping rehearsal set up, positioning chairs, handing out lanyards, taking registration etc)
- Assisting with warm ups, demonstrations and musical activities, and taking responsibility for smaller groups of the choir in short tasks
- Offering individual pastoral, behavioural or musical support to members, where appropriate
- Understanding the importance of safeguarding and protection of young people
- Committed to attending weekly term time rehearsals for the duration of the academic year

### **Additional Information**

### **Current Fee Structure**

£45 per 2-hour rehearsal and £22.50 per hour for concerts and events. You are expected to be registered as self-employed and therefore responsible for your own Tax and National Insurance. **All LYC freelance fees are under review for the 24/25 academic year**.

All successful candidates will also be required to attend a small number of paid face-to-face training sessions throughout the year as well as completing compulsory online safeguarding training.

### Safeguarding

London Youth Choirs is committed to safeguarding and protecting the children and young people that we work with. We ensure that our organisation has a range of policies and procedures in place so that we can do everything possible to safeguard our choir members.

Applicants should already be registered on the DBS Update Service, or be willing to undergo a new check with LYC before commencing work with us.

### **Equality and Diversity**

At London Youth Choirs, it is our core belief that opportunities to work and develop should be open to all. We have processes in place to ensure that all job applications are assessed fairly, regardless of age, disability, gender identity or gender expression, race, ethnicity, religion or belief, sex, sexual orientation or any other protected characteristics. We want a more equal, inclusive and representative choral and cultural sector. We particularly encourage applications from disabled people and people from Black, Asian and minority ethnic backgrounds, as these groups are currently underrepresented in our workforce.

All roles commence on **Monday 9th September** with a full freelance team training evening. Regular rehearsals begin in the week of **16th September**.
